How it works

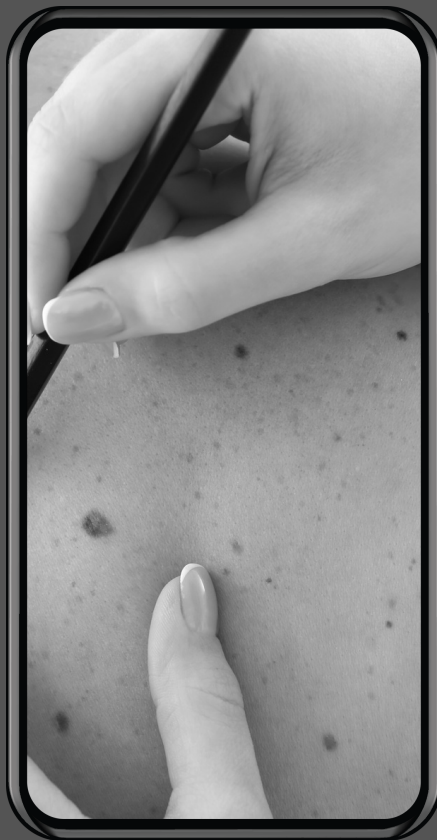

What Aesthetics Procedures do you perform?

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How long will it be until I see results?

It varies depending on the procedure you have. For Anti Wrinkle Treatment we recommend booking a review appointment 2 weeks after, if your treatment needs to be topped up, it needs to be done in a 2 week window. For other types of procedures, it can take a few days to a few weeks to see the results. Some treatments work best as part of a series of treatments and others are needed less regularly.

Medical Aesthetics

Aesthetic medicine extends beyond cosmetic enhancement.

We provide treatments using Botulinum Toxin Type A for specific medical indications.

Hyperhidrosis is a recognised condition characterised by excessive sweating, which can significantly affect an individual's daily functioning and wellbeing. We also offer Botulinum Toxin Type A treatment for chronic migraine. While these treatments are not curative, they are clinically recognised for reducing symptom severity and frequency, offering patients measurable relief and improved quality of life.

All treatments are delivered by qualified and experienced clinicians following a full medical assessment and suitability screening.



Aesthetics Procedures

Anti Wrinkle Injections

When small facial muscles are repeatedly contracting (for example when frowning or squinting), lines and wrinkles can form. By relaxing these muscles, the overlying skin appears smoother.

The same mechanism can help conditions caused by overactive muscles or glands, such as:

- Hyperhidrosis (excessive sweating) – by blocking signals to sweat glands
- Chronic migraine – by reducing muscle tension and nerve signalling involved in pain pathways
- Jaw clenching or muscle spasm – by reducing excessive muscle activity

Treatment involves a series of small injections into muscles. The procedure is quick and you will begin to see results in 3-7 days, it may take up to 2 weeks to see full effect. The effects typically last for 3-4 months.

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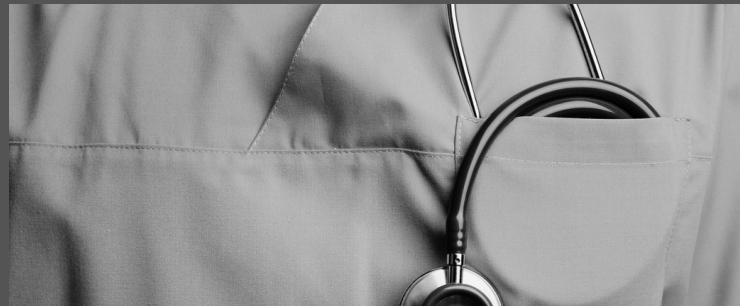
Dermal Filler

Dermal fillers are injectable gels, most commonly made from hyaluronic acid — a substance that occurs naturally in the body. Hyaluronic acid attracts and retains water, helping to maintain hydration, structure and volume within the skin.

As we age, natural levels of collagen, elastin and hyaluronic acid reduce. This can lead to volume loss, skin laxity and the formation of deeper lines and folds. Dermal fillers work by restoring lost volume, enhancing structure and supporting the surrounding tissue.

It is typically used for volume loss, softening of deeper lines and by supporting skin from beneath.

Treatment involves carefully placed injections to target areas. Most filler contains local anaesthetic for comfort. Results visible immediately and once swelling settles you will see the final result within 1-2 weeks. Results typically last for 6-18 months depending on the product used and area treated.



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Polynucleotides

Polynucleotides are highly purified fragments of DNA, typically derived from salmon or trout, that are used in regenerative aesthetic medicine. They are biostimulators meaning they stimulate the skin to repair and regenerate itself rather than simply adding volume.

When injected into the skin, polynucleotides work at a cellular level to:

- Stimulate fibroblasts (the cells responsible for producing collagen and elastin)
- Improve tissue repair and regeneration
- Increase hydration within the skin
- Reduce inflammation and oxidative stress
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Rather than changing facial shape or relaxing muscles, polynucleotides improve overall skin quality and health.

Treatment involves a series of superficial injections. Mild swelling or bumps are common initially but settle within 24-48 hours. A course of 2-3 treatments is generally recommended. Results develop over several weeks. Improvements can last up to 6 months.



Aesthetics Procedures

Non Surgical Face Lift

A non-surgical facelift uses dermal fillers strategically placed in key areas of the face to restore volume, lift sagging tissue, and improve facial contours. Unlike surgical facelifts, there is no incision or general anaesthetic — the procedure relies entirely on precise injections to achieve a lifted and rejuvenated appearance.

The fillers act as support structures beneath the skin, lifting and reshaping areas affected by ageing, while maintaining a natural look.

That means the procedure;

- Restores volume
- Smooths and softening lines
- Enhances facial structure
- Gives natural results

Mild swelling and redness or bruising may occur but resolves in a few days. Results take 1-2 weeks to settle. Effects can last up to 18 months depending on products used and treatment area.

A perfect alternative to surgery.

Skin Boosters

Skin Boosters are injectable treatments that use hyaluronic acid to deeply hydrate and improve the quality of your skin. Unlike traditional fillers that add volume or reshape the face, Skin Boosters work within the skin itself, enhancing hydration, elasticity, and overall skin health from the inside out.

The treatment delivers tiny amounts of hyaluronic acid into the superficial layers of the skin, stimulating collagen and elastin production and improving the skin's texture and resilience.

That means the procedure;

- Provides deep hydration
- Improves texture and elasticity
- Provides subtle rejuvenation
- Is suitable for delicate areas.

Treatment involves a series of micro injections, redness, swelling and tiny bumps may occur but usually settle within 24-48 hours. A course of 2-3 sessions are usually recommended. Improvements are gradual and become noticeable over several weeks. Results generally last for 6-12 months depending on skin condition.

Our next new service will be Thread Lifts

A Thread Lift is a minimally invasive procedure that lifts and supports sagging facial tissue using biodegradable threads. Unlike surgical facelifts, Thread Lifts don't require large incisions or general anaesthetic. The threads are inserted under the skin and anchored to lift areas of the face, providing a subtle, natural-looking lift.

Results are immediate with further improvement over 4-12 weeks. The results last for 12-18 months typically.

Thread Lifts are an excellent option for patients seeking facial lifting and rejuvenation without surgery, with minimal downtime and natural-looking results.
